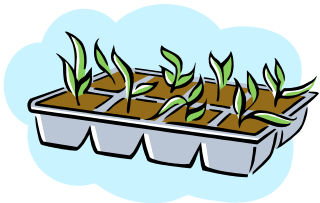


Cornell Cooperative Extension's mission is to enable people to **improve their lives and communities** through partnerships that put experience and research knowledge to work.
